Kathie Kelly: Biography & Filmography

Kathie Kelly began filming in Super8 in Berkeley, California in1972 and created several scripted short films. Discouraged by the lack of opportunities for women in film, she returned to science in 1974. She earned a PhD in Physical Oceanography from Scripps Institution of Oceanography. For over 30 years she conducted research in ocean circulation and climate change at Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution and at the University of Washington, primarily funded by NASA. She is a Fellow of the American Meteorological Society.

In 2010 she retooled for film with classes at Shoreline Community College and Northwest Film Forum. She re-edited some Super8 films and wrote and directed four narrative shorts. In 2016 she retired from science research to devote her energy to filmmaking.
